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Project Goals

- Create community web resource for migration planning
- Develop software tooling for migration to Hyku





Phase 1 (10/2017-04/2018)

- Onboard Content Strategist
- Create website
- Gather and analyze information about partner institutions' digital collections environment
 - Including: collection size, content types, system dependencies, metadata schemas, workflows, stakeholder considerations
- Gather information about Hyku requirements and limitations
 - Including: content types available, metadata configuration, access controls, user interface


Phase 2 (04/2018-4/2019)

- Adopt, adapt, and develop migration software for CONTENT dm to Hyku migration
- Test and improve software
- Publish migration case studies to website

Phase 3 (4/2019-9/2019)

- Solicit community feedback on toolkit
- Share toolkit with community through presentations, workshops, etc.
- Ensure sustainability
