
## **Targeted Education Increases Medication Compliance in Older Adults**

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### Synthesis

- Lack of medication compliance is common among older people (ages 65+)<sup>1-7</sup>
- among older patients and leads to decreased medication compliance.<sup>1, 2, 4, 5, 7-9</sup>
- Increased medication compliances leads to improved patient outcomes.<sup>5-8, 10</sup>

- Increased family involvement improves medication compliance. <sup>7, 9-11</sup>



#### **Medication Compliance & Education**

• Lack of understanding of medications is the primary barrier to medication compliance • Health complications arise when there is non-compliance with medication regimens.<sup>1, 2, 6, 7</sup> • Education is crucial to promoting medication compliance among older adults.<sup>2, 4, 7, 8</sup> • Follow-up educational support measures improve medication compliance.<sup>4, 7-10</sup>
